STUDENT GUIDELINE

1. Participation Requirements

Participation in the Peer Assisted Learning Program as either a peer leader or a student receiving support is voluntary.

Students wishing to become peer leaders must:

- Have passed the relevant course with at least a BA grade (3.5/4.0 or equivalent),
- Have no disciplinary record,
- Be recommended by a faculty member or advisor.

2. Responsibilities

Peer Leader:

- Must organize at least one support session per week during the program.
- Should focus on explaining concepts, solving problems, and sharing study strategies rather than teaching the course.
- Must complete a short report or feedback form after each session.
- Must adhere to ethical rules and confidentiality.

Student Receiving Support:

- Must regularly attend scheduled sessions.
- Should participate actively, ask questions, and contribute to group interaction.
- Must complete the end-of-term evaluation survey.

3. Evaluation and Certification

- Participation and performance are evaluated under the supervision of the course instructor.
- At the end of the term, successful participants may receive a participation certificate or peer leadership certificate.
